Campus Philly Introduces New Events and Resources for College Students and Young Professionals

The two recruiting events – [Life Sciences and Tech](#), and day one of [JobFEST](#) – will take place on Brazen, where attendees can connect with employers via video or text chat, offering an accessible and “low pressure” networking experience for job seekers. Career events will also feature panel discussions with young professionals sharing practical career advice on how to launch a career in the fastest-growing industries in Philadelphia, and what it’s like to work at companies like Google, Comcast, and companies in the rapidly expanding life sciences sector.

In a targeted approach to engage recent graduates looking to “find their fit” in Philadelphia, Campus Philly has launched the [“Philly Night Out”](#) series of free and discounted events at iconic

venues across the city, encouraging both college students and those who are a few years out of school to explore a new neighborhood, experience something new, and connect with others to build community. “Philly Night Out” attendees are encouraged to utilize Campus Philly’s [Neighborhood Guide](#) to grab a bite to eat, visit local shops, and explore the neighborhood with others before or after the event.
